Measurement Choices

Measurement for a map scale can be given in inches, feet, and miles. This type of measurement is called **standard measure**.

Measurement for a map scale can also be given in centimeters, meters, and kilometers. This type of measurement is called *metric measure*.


On some map scales, both **standard** and **metric** measure are used. It is good to learn how to read and use both kinds of measurement systems.


When we choose a scale to use, it needs to be suited to the type of map we are making.


